Rules

Article 1 - Competition

Registrations are open for the "Alicante Dance International", an international dance choreographic competition. Initially the competition is reserved only for participants in the ADI festival. If, once the festival registrations close, there is space to accommodate further choreographies in the competition, registrations will also be open to external participants.

Article 2 - Category

Section

Kids (by 10 y.o.)	Teen (from 11 to 13 y.o.)
Under (from 14 to 16 y.o.)	Over (from 17 to 25 y.o.)
Master (from 26 y.o. To up)	

To define the section, take the mathematical average of the years of birth only (e.g. dancer born in 2010=16 years)

To ensure the competition, some categories or sections may be merged.

Article 3 - exhibition time

Soloists max 2'00"

Duo max 3'00"

Group / Crew max 4'00"

Mega Group / Mega Crew max 4'30"

Tolerance 20%

If this limit is exceeded, the music will fade when the maximum time is reached

Article 4 - judges criteria

Performances will be evaluated according to the following criteria:
technique / choreography / expressiveness

Article 5 – organization and logistic

Participants must complete their registration on the platform www.concorsi-danza.com from July 1 to July 31, 2026.

The competition will take place on a stage with the following dimensions: 10 x 10 meters.

Article 6 - fees

The registration fee is €45.00 for soloists;
the registration fee is €35.00 each for duos;
the registration fee is €20.00 each for each member of the group/crew.

The registration fee will not be refunded in the event of spontaneous withdrawal of the participant.

Article 7 - prize

3° place. TROPHY/PLATE + scholarship
from 4° place. scholarship

Only the top 3 classified in each category are awarded on stage

Article 8 - jury

The jury selected by the organization will decide the winners.
There may be ties among the winners. The jury's decision will be final.
